Dear Parents / Carers,

We are in communication with the local police and more parking checks will be taking place.

Also this week, I received an email from a parent who witnessed another parent smoking an illegal substance just outside the school grounds. This is not what we expect from any parent and I ask that this does not happen again. Police have also been contacted about this.

A massive thank you to Felicity M's parents in 2C for donating lots of bulbs for our outdoor planters - these will really brighten up the space. Year 2s are going to learn about the bulbs during science next week when they are exploring micro habitats.
