## **Story Telling Magic**

We were really pleased that Hannah Brailsford, storyteller, visited our school on Monday this week. The parents and families of our Nursery children were invited into school to share the storytelling session with their children. In the session, we all caught a story and we made a story cake. We added our own ideas and our characters. We had a camel called Pyjama, a dinosaur called Blackberry and her friend Red the dinosaur.

We ended the session by thinking about how we can tell our own stories using things that we have in our own houses, like a spoon, a soft toy lion, a leaf and a cup! Everyone who attended received a special 'Storytelling Shopping Bag'. The children and parents were really excited to take these bags home and collect objects, pop them in the bag ready to tell a story with them. We can't wait to hear the children tell these stories. We will be holding a follow up session for Nursery children and parents in November.

The Reception children also had a storytelling session with Hannah. The characters in their story included Anthony the Prince, Iris the Fairy, Annabelle the Princess and Issac the Camel. We all had so much fun joining in with the story.


#### **Homework**
