Dear Parents / Carers,

This week the children in Years 5 and 6 undertook an orienteering day which they thoroughly enjoyed. Thank you to the staff involved for making this happen.

On the 7th May, we will be hosting a Number Day which is to support the NSPCC. You will have received a letter about this event earlier in the week and more details will be in next week's newsletter.



At the start of the week, we undertook a number of interviews and are pleased to announce that we have multiple new staff joining us from September; one appointment linked directly to the new SEMH provision that we are setting up. This will be an amazing provision for our school, supporting children from all age ranges with their social, emotional and mental health. The intention is to repurpose the wraparound care building so that it is the SEMH provision and it will be led by a highly-qualified teacher.

As a result of this, the wraparound care (breakfast and after school clubs) will return once again to the Burnsfield Hall. In the near future, I will be writing to gather your views on wraparound care so that we can tweak our current offer to engage more families. As you know, the provision has run at a deficit for a number of years and this cannot financially continue into next year. Therefore, we need to get a better understanding of what parents need before and after school so that we can gauge demand for the provision in September and beyond.

You will have also received a survey link for Premier Sport who are trying to find out whether there is a requirement for half-term and holiday clubs. Without your responses, we will not be able to gauge whether this is necessary so please do fill it in—thank you.

On a completely separate note, I am tightening up on school uniform now that the

children are back to a relative normality within our setting. This means that apart from on their PE days, staff will be encouraging children to wear full uniform. Those children whose sensory needs have been discussed with the school will continue to be able to wear different attire, albeit still in the school colours where possible. Thank you in advance for your help with this.


