This week we have been learning about Harvest Festival in school. Children learned about how harvest has been celebrated since Pagan times in this country and about how Christians still celebrate and say thank you for the safe harvest of our food. In yesterday's singing assembly, Claire and Juliette (from the Church of St. Peter and St. Paul) joined us for a singing assembly where the songs were themed around harvest. Slip Into Slippers Charity Day - 7th October 2022: This coming Friday we are supporting Age UK's Slip into Slippers campaign by encouraging children to come into school with slippers to wear while inside. All donations received will go to this campaign which supports local older people. Please ensure children have a pair of outside shoes with them as well for break time and lunch time.

7th October - Year 2 visit to King Edward Centre: To continue their understanding of the history of our school in our community, Year 2 are visiting the King Edward Centre to learn about how it was the original site of the King Edward School. Children will return to school in time for the end of the school day. Please ensure they have a suitable coat for the weather.

7th October - Year 1 Bikeability – Year 1 children will be learning the early skills of riding a bike which can be used when riding on roads when they are much older. Upcoming Skipping Workshop

On 13th October, the school will be hosting another skipping day which will be offered as a free event. All children will watch a skipping demonstration to get them motivated and Key Stage 2 children will take part in a follow-up workshop. This will support children to become active and to improve their skipping skills. We will be offering the opportunity for children to buy a skipping rope through ParentMail from Monday which are branded ropes from the workshop. These will be handed out after the workshop and will cost £5. If you would like to buy a rope, please pay by Tuesday 11th October so that the correct number can be ordered and delivered on the day.


