Football Fun Day at Kingsfield Primary School!

On Thursday, the Football Fun Factory held a Football Fun Day at Kingsfield Primary School for KS2 children. This gave the children a chance to experience the truly unique football experiences the FFF offers to children in our local community.

The children dived around on the inflatable goal and shot at our giant dartboard. I hope they all enjoyed themselves as much as we did.

At the FFF, we run weekly Football Fun and Development sessions on a Wednesday for 5-12 year olds, and also Tots Football Fun sessions on a Saturday 9:00-11:00am for 2-5 year olds. We also are running our Football Fun Camps this summer in Chatteris. These give children a chance to experience the fun and exciting inflatables again. Our camps are running Monday—Friday for the 4 weeks of August.
