




EYFS Newsletter



In English, we will be covering:

The use of story language, characters & settings and how stories are structured



We will learn to retell and sequence stories and change characters in order to create our own stories. Another focus will be on letter formation and the blending and segmenting of words in both reading and writing .

In Maths, we will be covering: Counting reliably with numbers 0-10 and then 0-20. Placing these numbers in order and saying which number is one more or one less than a given number. We will also be looking at using everyday language to talk about size, shape, weight, capacity, position, distance, time and money.



In Understanding the World, we are going to be investigating materials and their properties as well as the children talking about similarities and differences between themselves and others.

In Expressive arts and design, we will look at safely using and exploring a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. We will also be encouraging children to express themselves through role-play and stories.

Homework: In EYFS ,we place a big emphasis on reading. Please try and read with your child at least 3 times a week and record in their diary so we can change books.
